



OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Be sure equipment is connected to properly grounded 120 volt power supply with 15 amp circuit.

Popping

- Turn on two switches.

 POWER and KETTLE.
- Allow kettle to warm for approximately 5 minutes.
- PORTION PACKS: Cut off top of plastic pack. Dump entire contents in kettle. Pull lid closed to prevent stray kernels. (Lid is held in place by magnet directly above the kettle.)
- While corn is popping, keep front operator doors closed. Keep hopper door at "out" position to reduce fogging.
- Allow com to pop until popping ceases, usually when 3-4 seconds lapse between pops.
 Immediately turn Kettle switch to off position to avoid burning of popcorn. Then pour remaining popped com from kettle by rotating handle clockwise 1/3 turn and pulling downward.
- Repeat steps 1-5 for additional batches.
- POWER or LIGHT switch may remain ON to display and heat popcom.

KETTLE WILL BE HOT! Please be sure to avoid direct contact with the kettle during the popping process!
